



Professor Kang Chong is currently Party Secretary and Deputy Director of the Institute of Botany, the Chinese Academy of Sciences (IBCAS) and serves as the President of the Botanical Society of China. He earned his PhD in 1993

in Lanzhou University. Prof. Chong obtained NSFC funding as a distinguished young scholar in 2006 and was enrolled as a national member of "New Century Hundreds and Thousands of Talents Project". He was the national correspondent of the International Association of Plant Biotechnology and the president of the chromosome genome protein branch of the Chinese Society for Cell Biology. He was elected as an academician of the Chinese Academy of Sciences in 2017.

The Chong lab focuses on functional genomics of organogenesis and development in rice, plant response mechanism to environmental factors and molecular mechanisms of vernalization. Prof. Chong has published more than 60 papers on scientific journals, such as Cell, the EMBO Journal, Plant Cell, PNAS, PLoS Genetics, Nature Communications and Genome Biology. He is also chief editor of Chinese Bulletin of Botany and editorial board member of Plant Cell Reports, JIPB and Journal Plant Physiology.
